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Pocket Money and Tobacco Purchases: A Parent's Role

Dear Parents

Greetings.

The school wishes to create awareness about a specific concern: students using pocket money to purchase tobacco products. Small, frequent purchases can sometimes go unnoticed, especially when parents are unaware of how their child's pocket money is being spent.

Parents are requested to:

- Give age-appropriate amounts of pocket money and discuss how it should be used.
- Encourage children to be open about what they purchase.
- Take unexplained requests for extra money seriously without immediately assuming wrongdoing.
- Remind children that they should never purchase, carry, or accept tobacco products for themselves or others.
- Encourage children to tell a trusted adult if someone asks them to buy tobacco products.

Parents do not need to monitor every purchase. Instead, regular and non-judgmental conversations about money and spending can help children make safer choices.

The school will address any reported concerns and inform parents where necessary.

Small conversations at home can prevent bigger problems later.
